# How to reach us

The conference will be held in Milano Bicocca U7 building, adjacent to via B. degli Arcimboldi and Piazza dell'Ateneo Nuovo.

For long distance travellers, the best solution is to reach **Milano P.ta Garibaldi** train station and make a 5 min train trip (very frequent service) to Milano Greco Pirelli (10 min. walk to the University)

More detailed information is provided below.

### **By Train**

The closest station to the University of Milano-Bicocca is **Milano Greco Pirelli** (served by regional trains).

Taking Viale dell'Innovazione, a street adjacent to the Arcimboldi theatre, you reach Piazza dell'Ateneo Nuovo and the U6/U7 buildings.

If you take a long distance train best choice is MIlano **Porta Garibaldi** and a 5 minutes train trip to Greco Pirelli.

If your train arrive in Milano Centrale you can take bus 87 (20 minutes).

## By Local Public Transport

#### o **Tram**

**Line 7**: Arcimboldi Ateneo Nuovo stop for buildings U6/U7, Bicocca Scienza University for buildings near Piazza della Scienza.

Line 31 (Cinisello to Isola): San Glicerio stop

o **Bus** 

**Line 87 (Centrale to Sesto S. Giovanni)**: runs through the University buildings.

Line 51 (Zara to Cimiano): Ponale Testi stop.



**Lines 81 (sesto Marelli-Centrale-Lambrate) and 86 (Niguarda-via Padova)**: stop at Breda Rucellai, you can use the pedestrian underpass to reach the University

Line 728 (Cinisello-Bignami): Milano Greco stop (terminus)

### By plane



From **Milan Linate** airport you can take the **M4** underground line (Blue line), which leads to S. Babila, where you can continue with the M1 line (Red line).

Those arriving at **Milan Malpensa** airport can take the <u>Malpensa Express</u> shuttle train. It is advisable to use the trains that stop at Milan Porta Garibaldi station. Alternatively, from Cadorna station you can continue on underground line 1, direction Sesto 1° Maggio F.S.

### By car

From the Turin-Venice motorway, take the "**Milano - Viale Zara**" exit and head towards Milano Centro.

After passing the sign for the Municipality of Milan, at the StarTourist Hotel on the left, take **Viale Sarca**, the first street parallel to the one you are walking on the left.

Continuing along Viale Sarca in the same direction you will find the University on your left, after about a kilometer.
